For Minor Associations that do not currently have a process for player selection they are encouraged to use the following suggested process to help with the selection of a candidate for this scholarship;

- President or designate to inform all Midget age appropriate Box Lacrosse players, coaches and managers about scholarship, providing timeline and follow-up as necessary
- Box Lacrosse Players/Parents or Associations to complete necessary application to the local association (use this form)
- Executive to elect committee (3 people minimum) to choose candidate from applications
- Committee to send association's successful applicant into BCLA office
- Will be presented at Midget Provincials. If not attending, then the Zone Director will contact the Zone winner to discuss the opportunity to present the award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- To be chosen on a zonal basis.
- Each Association may nominate one Box Lacrosse player meeting the necessary requirements. **Please submit this nomination to the <u>BCLA Office</u>**, #101 7382 Winston Street, Burnaby, B.C., V5A 2G9 by **Monday, May 27, 2019.**
- The nominations will be forwarded to each Zone Director, with the Zone winner's nomination to be brought to the June 2019 Minor Directorate Meeting by the Zone Directors.
- All **Zone Winners** will receive a \$500 scholarship (to be held in trust for any post-Secondary education including university, college, night or trade school) and jacket as their award for being a Zone winner.
- The **over-all Box Lacrosse Player of the Year Winner** will receive a jacket and a **\$1,000.00** (\$500 for Zone Winner, \$500 additional) Scholarship to be held in trust for any post-Secondary education including university, college, night or trade school.
- This application may also be used for other recognition.

Requirements for the Box Lacrosse Player of the Year are as follows:

- 1. Must be a Registered Minor Box Lacrosse player born in 2003.
- 2. Should be an above-average Box Lacrosse player within his/her association.
- 3. Should give extra back to Box Lacrosse such as Coaching, Refereeing, Scorekeeping, and other box lacrosse volunteer activities, please list on form provided.
- 4. Must be a team leader, on and off the floor.
- 5. Should have a consistent academic standard.

To receive consideration, ONLY the following information should be submitted:

- Attached Form outlining the Box Lacrosse player's accomplishments and involvement in box lacrosse.
- A letter from the Association recommending the candidate, including comments from the Head Coach and Head Referee.
- A copy of the current school transcript
- A photograph must accompany the nomination.
