Langley Events Centre continues to monitor the COVID-19 situation in British Columbia and is following the Orders, directives and guidelines put in place by Health Authorities, the Province and WorkSafeBC.

The Provincial Health Officer has updated the <u>Gathering and Events</u> order to incorporate proof of vaccination requirements.

As of September 13, in accordance with the Health Order, anyone 12 years of age or older who choose to participate in certain indoor events or activities offered at LEC will be expected to show Proof of Vaccination at time of arrival. Proof of vaccination is required each time someone participates in one of the listed indoor activities.

Those who are 12-18 years of age will be required to produce their Proof of Vaccination only; those aged 19 years of age and older will be required to show both their Proof of Vaccination and a piece of valid government issued photo ID.

The following are included in the requirements:

Events

- Indoor ticketed events
- Indoor organized events with 50 or more people (including but not limited to: organized parties, conferences and workshops, games, and tournaments)

Sports

- Spectators 12 years of age or older for all indoor games and tournaments
- Indoor adult (22 years of age or older) sports. This includes rental group participants, and drop-in gym sports participants

Exempt activities and programs

The following programs and services are exempt from the Order, and Proof of Vaccination will not be required for access:

• Those participating in youth sport (21 years of age and younger) for practice or training, including any adult coaches, volunteers and spectators

As a reminder, masks remain required for those 12 years of age and older inside LEC facilities, unless participating in physical activity when on the field/court/surface of play.
