Rationale: The \$8 per player increase in registration fees is that these additional dollars will cover

the \$6 increase that Lacrosse Canada has implemented per player. This increase comes after years of a \$4 fee per player. The \$6 is an effort to “catch up” to “today’s dollars”. Please note we already know there will be an additional \$5 increase per player for Lacrosse Canada next year. That will bring the cost per player to \$15.

The other \$2 will go towards BCLA costs and is in line with current cost of living increases.

The additional \$15 for Insurance for Senior & Junior teams is simply to ensure we have enough money to pay for our insurance which has increased from \$60k annually to over \$100k.

Also change “Junior” to U22 for Girls Minor Box Lacrosse.

Increase in fees

The rationale: It is getting harder and harder to compete with minimum wage jobs and continue to attract and retain officials. The cost of living has continued to rise.
