The Coaches Meeting is mandatory for all coaches participating in the Provincials.

TEAM ROSTER VERIFICATION

This year Game Sheets (RAMP) will be used so there is no need for a roster submission to the host.

Call up players: If your team has added call up players (AP) you need to submit an updated roster verification form to debheard@bclacrosse.com with those players added and noted as such. The DEADLINE for such is this Friday, July 4th by noon so the office can review/approve such additions to rosters.

Schedule: Updates of the complete Provincial Schedule can be found on the BCLA website. *Host directors have nothing to do with scheduling so please do not direct questions to them*

Time/Score Keepers: For each of your round robin games, the team slotted as the Home Team will be responsible for providing a timekeeper and teams slotted as Away Team will be responsible for providing a scorekeeper.

The Team Officials (Managers or Coaches) are asked to have the names of their applicable volunteer ready at each game check-in.

Please make sure your volunteers are familiar with both RAMP and the nevco clock system. *please instruct time keepers to not fiddle with the clocks or try to change any of the settings* Venues: We have three venues for this year's event. Note: pets are not allowed inside the facilities and the use of air (or electric) horns is absolutely prohibited inside the facilities.

Nanaimo Ice Center rink 1 located at 750 Third Street, Nanaimo Frank Crane Arena (Beban Park) located at 23 Bowen Rd. Nanaimo Fuller Lake Arena located at 2876 Fuller Lake Road, Chemanius

For driving purposes, Nanaimo arenas are approximately 9 minutes apart. Fuller lake is 35 minutes from Frank Crane and 29 minutes from Nanaimo Ice Center

Dressing Rooms: Rooms will be assigned and posted inside each arena. Dressing rooms should be vacated within 30 minutes of the end of each game to allow time for the following team to prepare for their game. Your room will be available for you 50 minutes prior to your game - please do not check in prior to that time. It is the responsibility of each team to monitor their players while in the dressing room and at the Provincials. Rooms are to be left clean - garbage/tape in the cans, water dumped in the drain and not the trash, all personal items removed.

 Any damage incurred to rooms will be charged back to the Team's Home Association who was deemed to have damaged the facility. This is NON NEGOTIABLE.

Important Information for Coaches:

- Coaches have the responsibility to ensure the safety of their players. Please bring a team first aid kit.

- Please familiarize yourself with the 2025 Minor Box Provincial Directive.
- It is recommended that you hold your own Team Meeting after this Coaches Meeting and prior to your first game to advise your Team and Team Parents of the necessary and important information they will need to know.
- You are responsible for the behaviour of your fans. Should there be a problem in the stands, games will be • halted until the offender(s) leave the arena. Gender Equity Policy and the Fair Play Code for Coaches, Parents and Athletes as well as the BCLA Social Media Policy.

Medal Presentations: Medals will be presented after each of the final games on July 13th at the arenas played in. There will be no Closing Ceremony.
