



2026 MINOR BOX PROVINCIAL DECLARATION

All teams wishing to declare for Provincials **MUST** fill out this form in **FULL**. Associations should submit all forms and the declaration fee to the BCLA office rather than each team submitting to reduce duplication.

All required Association registration paperwork must be submitted prior to **May 25, 2026**, or the Association's team(s) will be unable to declare for Provincial Championships.

DECLARATION FEE

Each team declaring to participate in Playoffs/Provincials must have a declaration form and declaration fee to the BCLA. It is the association's responsibility to deliver completed forms (pdf 2 page declaration/excel 1 page roster) **along with the declaration fee of \$250** for each declared team **to the BCLA by May 25, 2026 4:00 PM.**

PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP FEE

NEW THIS SEASON (2026) per the Minor Directorate there is an **additional fee of \$250** for teams that secure a spot in the Provincial Championships.

Payment method below and due one week prior to championships.

If a team withdraws from participation in the Provincial Championships or Playoffs after declaration, the home association could be fined \$1,000.00.

After a provincial berth is confirmed/assigned, the home association could be subject to a \$3,000.00 fine per team that withdraws

You are required to provide a verification roster one week prior to the start of provincials to the BCLA office **ONLY** if there are **ANY changes** to the roster originally submitted with the declaration form & fees.

NOTE

For "C" teams, per Regulation 12.05 (g), teams are required to submit their team lists for validation to the Provincial Director seventy-two (72) hours (3 days) prior to the start of Provincial Championships.

*Per Lacrosse Canada Age & Stage Appropriate Modifications 2.0 **FOUR (4) coaches & ONE (1) trainer are allowed on the bench.** You can list as many trained coaches as you need on this form, but only four(4) will be allowed on the bench at any time. The team trainer shall be included on the bottom of the score sheet. All personnel on the bench shall have as the minimum one of the following accreditations: All coaches must meet the minimum requirements outlined on the Form 100B; Trainers who at minimum possesses a "First Responder" or has successfully attended the Trainer's Aid Course.*

Any changes to coaches on submitted Provincial Declarations must be submitted to the BCLA Technical Director two (2) weeks prior to the start of the provincial. Any changes past this deadline need to go to the Minor Directorate and BC Coaches Group.
