Arena Guidelines

- Air horns are not permitted in the arena.
- Other noisemakers are welcome provided they do not interfere with the shot clock, game clock, or officials' whistles.
- Any noisemaker that interferes with play may be confiscated.

Warm-up area information will be distributed to all participating teams. Please do not use common hallways, parking areas, or other public spaces for warm-ups. Wall ball is not permitted inside the facility.

Parking

Parking is available at the Kin Centre Complex. Please follow all posted parking regulations and be respectful of neighbouring businesses and facilities.

Dressing Rooms

Dressing room assignments will be posted at registration.

To obtain a dressing room key, the Manager or Coach signing the game sheet must leave their vehicle keys at Tournament Headquarters.

Please note:

- Teams should arrive no earlier than 45 minutes before game time.
- Dressing rooms must be vacated within 30 minutes after each game.
- Rooms must be left clean and free of damage.
- Any facility damage will be charged back to the responsible Home Association.
- Team staff are responsible for supervising players in dressing rooms and throughout the event.
- Vehicle keys will be returned once the dressing room has been inspected for cleanliness and damage.

Rosters

Game Sheets (RAMP) will be used throughout the tournament. Teams are not required to submit separate rosters to the host association.

Time/Score Keepers

For each of your round robin games, the team slotted as the **AWAY Team** will be responsible for providing a **timekeeper**, and teams slotted as the **HOME Team** will be responsible for providing a **scorekeeper** (*Game Sheets-RAMP*). The Team Officials (Managers or Coaches) are asked to have the names of their applicable volunteers ready at each game check-in.

Schedule

The most current Provincial Championship schedule will be available on the BCLA website. As teams qualify, schedules will be updated and populated with team names.

Important Information for Coaches

- Pick up your lanyard and coaching credentials from the Provincial Office prior to your first game. Credentials must be worn while on the bench.
- Review the 2026 Minor Box Provincial Directive.
- Coaches wishing to use an alternate goaltender must obtain written approval from the BCLA Minor Box Provincial Director before the championship and confirm player eligibility.
- Coaching staff have been verified through the Provincial Declaration Form. Only approved coaches may be on the bench during Provincials.
- All coaches must possess the required training and certification for the division they are coaching.
- It is recommended that each team hold a meeting with players and parents following the Coaches Meeting to review tournament expectations and important event information.

Medal Presentations

Medals will be presented immediately following each final game.

REMINDERS:

- Coaches are responsible for ensuring the safety and well-being of their players.
- Players should bring their own water bottles. Summer temperatures can make arena floors very warm, and water bottles must not be shared.
- Teams are responsible for the conduct of their spectators. If issues arise in the stands, play may be suspended until the individual(s) involved leave the facility.
- Please refer to the BCLA Operating Policy for the Code of Conduct, Harassment Policy, Gender Equity Policy, Fair Play Codes for Coaches, Parents, and Athletes, and the Social Media Policy.
- There will be a stoppage in all games on Thursday, July 9, to allow for our Opening Ceremonies and official welcome. All teams, players, coaches, officials, and spectators are encouraged to attend. Games will resume immediately following the conclusion of the ceremonies.
- There will be no closing ceremony.

Coverage Information

- Coverage will be limited to **up to two tournament floors only**.
- The specific floors covered will be posted at Eric's tournament booth.
- Teams interested in photography should check their schedules against the floors being covered.

Team Package (GST Included)

- **Early Bird Rate (until end of day Friday of tournament weekend):** \$446.25
- **Regular Rate:** \$525.00
- **Late Rate (one week after tournament):** \$603.75
- Team package includes a minimum target of **300 photos**.

Photo Guarantee

- If fewer than 300 photos are captured, pricing will be reduced proportionally.
- Example: 150 photos = 50% of package price.

Line Package Option

- Cost: \$315.00
- Covers up to 5 players.
- Includes 10 full-size digital downloads per player.

Individual Purchases

- Individual digital photos are available through Eric's online store.
- Best individual package: 5 full-size digital downloads for \$75.

Important Note

- Teams that already have a team or parent photographer may receive less coverage, as efforts will be focused on teams that have purchased photography services.
