TEAM ROSTER VERIFICATION

Will be completed in advance of the coaches meeting by the BCLA office to avoid delay at meeting and games.

Deadlines:

Monday February 17 all rosters submitted with your declaration form to the BCLA office will be considered your roster for provincials (If you have an updated roster send that updated roster verification form to debheard@bclacrosse.com).

All call-up players being used in the provincial championship must have played the required four (4) qualifying games with proof of play, a scan of the official score sheets. Please send to debheard@bclacrosse.com along with the callup form.

Tuesday February 18 the BCLA will review all submitted rosters with the RAMP registration system. Any issues will be addressed and resolved prior to the coaches meeting.

Wednesday February 19 is the last day any changes can be made to a roster and must be submitted to the BCLA office by 3:00PM. These would only be replacement players for players who have been injured and unable to play after our review Tuesday.

TEAM VOLUNTEERS

Each participating team must provide the following volunteers per round robin game: **HOME team to provide 1 timekeeper and AWAY team to provide 1 scorekeeper**. *Neutral score and time keepers will be provided for medal games.*

Each team should also appoint a responsible person for selecting game MVPs for round robin games. That person will select 3 players from the opposing team for each game. Players are only eligible for one award during the round robin portion of the tournament. *Neutral bench officials will select the medal game MVPs.*

Please have a team official report to the tournament office (Meeting Room #2 at Burnaby Lake West) thirty minutes prior to game time to pick up your score sheet and MVP awards sheet. Both of these will be returned to the tournament office by the officials immediately following the game.

GOGGLES

Approved goggles are **MANDATORY** for all players participating in the tournament. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

SUSPENSION GUIDELINES

Please read the attached Field Directorate Suspension. Any questions regarding the suspension guidelines should be referred to the Official in Chief (OIC).

VENUE

Players and team officials are requested to abide by venue rules at Burnaby Lake West. Players should be supervised in and around the facility, including change rooms.

NO LACROSSE BALLS are to be thrown or tossed against walls in or around the buildings at the venue. Balls and sticks will be confiscated by facility staff if this rule is violated.

Washrooms and change rooms are in the Facilities Building at Burnaby Lake West.

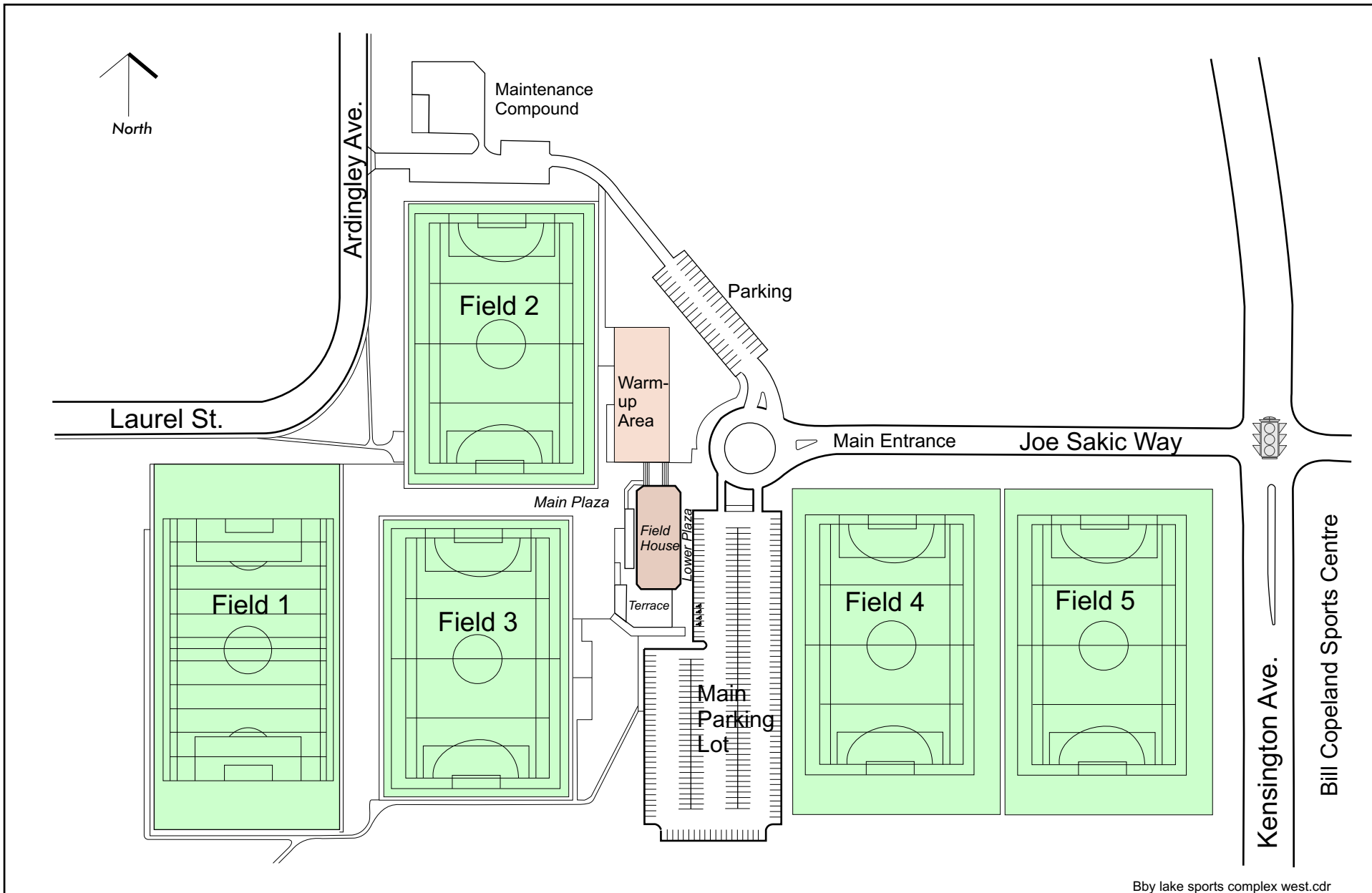
