THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2024 MANDATORY COACHES MEETING - 7:00 PM

Location: Burnaby Lake West, Meeting Room #2, 3677 Kensington Ave.

Team Confirmation: Done at the coaches meeting to avoid delay at game time. *This includes call-ups.*

Please only 1 coach and 1 manager per team as space is limited.

Any call-up player being used in the tournament has to have played the required three (3) qualifying games, proof of playing will be confirmed with *original official score sheets, either the pink or the yellow copy* (scans, photos, and/or photocopies will not be accepted).

TEAM VOLUNTEERS

Each participating team must provide the following volunteers per round robin game: **HOME team to provide 1 timekeeper and AWAY team to provide 1 scorekeeper**. Neutral score and time keepers will be provided for medal games.

Each team should also appoint a responsible person for selecting game MVPs for round robin games. That person will select 3 players from the opposing team for each game. Players are only eligible for one award during the round robin portion of the tournament. *Neutral bench officials will select the medal game MVPs*.

Please have a team official report to the tournament office (Meeting Room #2 at Burnaby Lake West) thirty minutes prior to game time to pick up your score sheet and MVP awards sheet. Both of these will be returned to the tournament office by the officials immediately following the game.

GOGGLES

Approved goggles are **MANDATORY** for all players participating in the tournament. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

SUSPENSION GUIDELINES

Please read the attached Field Directorate Suspension. Any questions regarding the suspension guidelines should be referred to the Official in Chief (OIC).





<u>VENUE</u>

Players and team officials are requested to abide by venue rules at Burnaby Lake West. Players should be supervised in and around the facility, including change rooms.

NO LACROSSE BALLS are to be thrown or tossed against walls in or around the buildings at the venue. Balls and sticks will be confiscated by facility staff if this rule is violated.

Washrooms and change rooms are in the Facilities Building at Burnaby Lake West.
