Surrey Lacrosse Association is proud to host the **2022-2023 U18 Tier 1 & 2, U15 Tier 1 & 2 and U13 Tier 1 & 2 Field Lacrosse Provincial Championships**. Please read this letter carefully as it includes important information you need to know before the provincials begin.

**Coaches/Managers MEETING (Mandatory)**

**All Teams**

**Thursday Feb 16th, 2023 at 7pm**

**Parking for Coaches/Manager meeting:** Paid - under the KPU building, at City Hall and at lots in the surrounding area. There isn't any free parking in the area due to the bus exchange/Skytrain Station so we recommend carpooling or taking transit.

Paperwork to bring to the meeting:

1. **Team Verification Form** (have it filled out and ready)
2. **Call-ups**. In order to provide proof that each call-up player has played the required three (3) qualifying games, be sure to bring **official game sheets** for confirmation.
3. **Fair Play Award Athlete Nomination Form** (have it filled out and ready)

**TEAM VOLUNTEERS Needed by each team DURING the Tournament:**

Before the game: Team Manager or designate should report to the tournament office **30** minutes prior to each game time to:

- a. check in and verify game day roster.
- b. add Coach name(s) and NCCP# to the game sheet.
- c. pick up game MVP award sheet. This will need to be returned to the office with the game sheet immediately following the game.
- d. Last team to check in will be responsible to take the game sheet to the field.

During the game:

- a. 1 volunteer per round robin game: one team to provide 1 timekeeper and the other team to provide 1 scorekeeper. (*Neutral score and timekeepers will be provided for medal games.*)
- b. 1 volunteer to select game MVPs for each round robin game. That person will select 3 players from the opposing team for each game. Players are only eligible for one award during the round robin portion of the tournament and the game sheet will be noted so referees will know who has already been chosen. *Neutral bench officials will select the medal game MVPs.*

## **GAME FORMAT**

All U18 / U15 / U13-2 games are 4 – 15 minute quarters.

All U13-1 round robin games are 4 – 10 minute quarters. Games need to start on the hour & run on time. Finals will be 4 – 15 minute quarters.

Breaks between quarters will be 2 minutes, 5 minutes, 2 minutes.

There will be 2 time outs per half.

The games are running time except:

1st, 2nd and 3rd Quarter - Stop Time Last 30 seconds

4th Quarter - Stop Time Last 2 Minutes if 5 goals or less

If stop time is started, it will continue to the end of the quarter regardless of goals being scored by either team.

NO OVERTIME DURING ROUND ROBIN – ties count one (1) point each team

## **OVERTIME RULES (for crossover and medal games only)**

In the event of the score being tied at the end of regulation playing time, play shall be continued, after a 2-minute intermission, with sudden victory overtime. In sudden victory overtime, teams shall play periods of 4-minutes each until a goal is scored, thus deciding a winner. The game ends upon the scoring of the first goal. There will be a 2-minute intermission between sudden victory periods.

No time-outs shall be allowed in a sudden victory overtime period

## **TIE BREAKER RULE - FULL ROUND ROBIN**

In the event of a tie in points, final standings shall be determined by the tie breaker-rule in the Provincial Directive.

## **SHOULDER PADS & MOUTHGUARDS**

Approved shoulder pads and mouthguards are **MANDATORY** for all players participating in the tournament. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

## **SUSPENSION GUIDELINES**

Please read the Field Directorate Suspension guidelines. Any questions regarding the suspension guidelines should be referred to the Tournament Convenor

## **VENUE**

**Newton Athletic Park, 7395 128 Street, Surrey BC V3W 2M7**

Games will be played on 4 fields: Field 1,2,5,6.

Please abide by all park rules as posted around the facility. Highlights include:

- Ensure all Garbage, including food & drink containers, is placed in garbage bins.
- No smoking/vaping in any area of the park.
- No alcohol drinking in any area of the park.
- Do not park on roadways or access areas.
- No parking on easement in front of Field #2.
- Players should be supervised in and around the facility.
- No urinating in the bushes. Please use the washrooms (3 locations).
- NO LACROSSE BALLS are to be thrown or tossed against walls. Facility or tournament staff will confiscate balls and sticks if this rule is violated.

Teams are to avoid warming up on the sidelines of the fields when there is a game running as warm up balls and players end up on the field of play. Warmup locations will be communicated at the Coaches/Managers Meeting.

### **TOURNAMENT AMENITIES**

On-site amenities include 3 washroom facilities, playground, water bottle refill station located on the west side of the club house (provided temperature is above zero), BCLA provincial souvenir apparel provided by Silver Ridge Promotions and Food Trucks (a variety throughout the weekend).

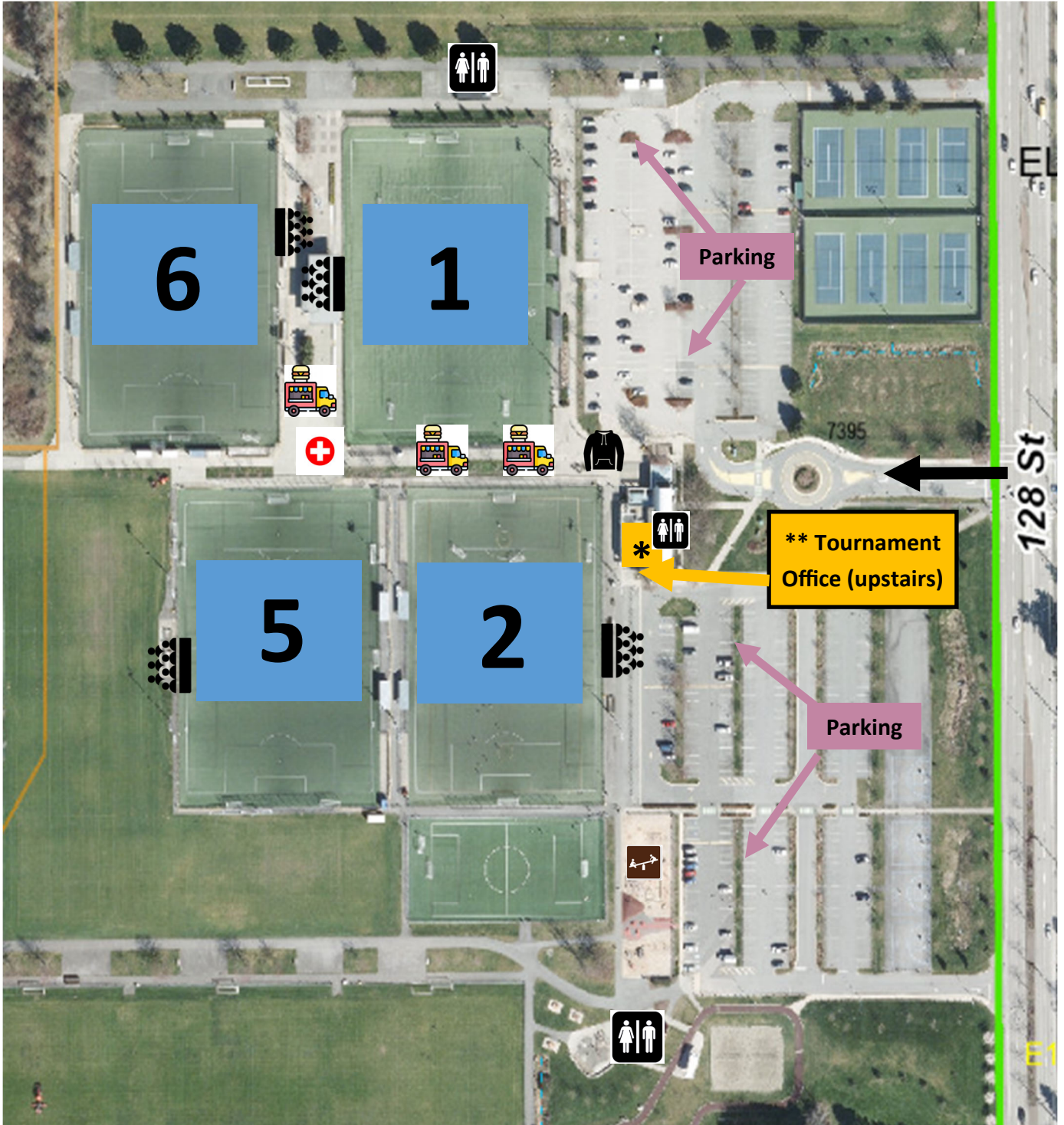
